



The Cullman County Museum and Festhalle Market Platz is located in downtown Cullman, Alabama.

We are mid-way between Huntsville, AL and Birmingham, AL via Interstate 65. Conveniently located less than 2 miles off I-65 and 2 blocks off U. S. Hwy. 31, we are very easy to find.

If traveling on I-65, take Exit 308 (Hwy. 278 exit) and turn east. Continue east approx. one mile crossing the railroad tracks bridge and turn north (left) on 2nd Ave. We are three blocks up on the left.

If traveling on U. S. Highway 31, turn east at Arnold St. NE, go two blocks across the railroad tracks, and you will see the Museum on the corner of Arnold St. N.E. and 2nd St. N.E.
