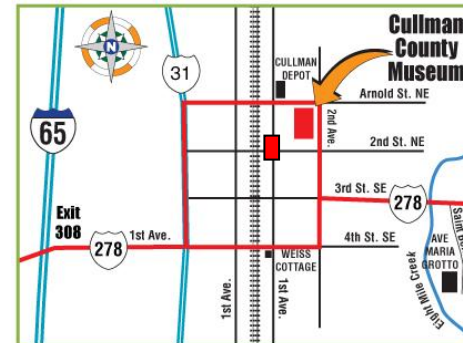

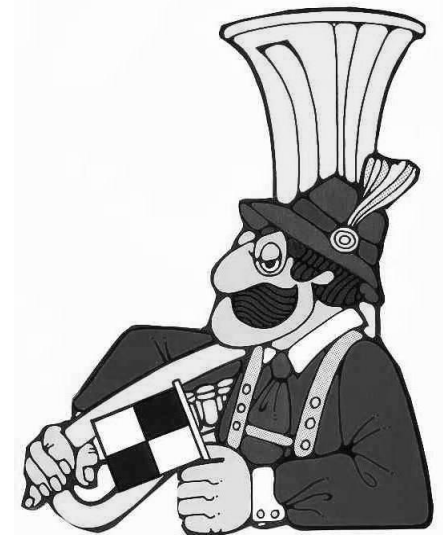

Continue east approx. one mile crossing the railroad tracks bridge and turn north (left) on 2nd Ave. We are three blocks up on the corner. If traveling on U.S Highway 31, turn east at Arnold St. NE, go two blocks across the railroad tracks and you will see the Museum on the corner of Arnold St. NE and 2nd Ave. N. E
